POVZETEK

Geološki zavod Slovenije opravlja na podlagi Zakona o rudarstvu tudi naloge Rudarske javne službe. Naloge Rudarske javne službe (RJS) so vodenje in vzdrževanje Rudarske knjige (sestavljena iz rudarskega registra ter rudarskega katastra), izdelava strokovnih podlag za državno rudarsko strategijo, prevzem rudarsko tehnične dokumentacije zaprtih rudnikov ter spremljava geoloških raziskav in prevzem vzorcev iz raziskovalnih izkopov, jaškov in vrtin. Delo vključuje tudi zbiranje/obdelavo in vodenje statističnih podatkov o proizvodnji ter zalogah in virih mineralnih surovin ter komunikacijo s širšo javnostjo. Sodelavci RJS sodelujejo pri implementaciji priporočil ter direktiv Evropske unije in sodelujejo v ekspertnih skupinah znotraj Združenja evropskih geoloških zavodov (EGS).

ABSTRACT

The work of the Public Mining Service is defined in the Mining Act and is being performed by the Geological Survey of Slovenia. Tasks of the Public Mining Service are keeping and maintaining the Mining Registry Book (consist of Mining cadastre and Mining register), preparing the expert basis for the national mining strategy, collecting samples from exploration of mineral resources (exploration digs, exploration shafts or exploration bore holes), and professional storage /archiving of closed mines documentation. The other activities of Public Mining Service are: collecting and data processing of mineral production, reserves and resources; also communication with wider and professional public. Public Mining Service experts are taking part in implementation of EU recommendations and directives and are members of different EGS Expert Groups.
