## **ABSTRACT**

Port Harcourt is a city characterized by economic, social and political activities. It is the nerve centre of oil and oil related businesses in Nigeria. This gives rise to a high influx of immigrants into this great city. It is popularly referred to as the treasure base of the nation. Most roads in Port Harcourt metropolis are swept on daily basis and also waste collectors do collect the solid wastes in most parts of the city. This not withstanding Port Harcourt city is still plagued with the problem of solid waste management. This problem is buttressed by the obvious heaps of solid wastes littered over most of the streets and the major roads of this great city.
