EU legislation on the soil protection

Povzetek

Evropska komisija je leta 2006 zaradi potrebe po obravnavanju proizvodnje sposobnosti tal ter tveganj za zdravje ljudi in okolje, zagotavljanju možnosti za blažitev podnebnih sprememb in prilagajanje nanje ter poslovnih priložnosti za sanacijo, predlagala krovno direktivo o varstvu tal, ki obravnava tudi čezmejne posledice degradacije tal. Zaradi pomena tal in potrebe po preprečitvi nadaljnje degradacije tal je bila v letu 2006 skladno s 6. Okoljskim akcijskim programom sprejeta Tematska strategija za varstvo tal. V letu 2011 je Evropska komisija sprejela časovni okvir za Evropo, gospodarno z viri, s katerim je napovedala nično neto izkoriščanje zemljišč do leta 2050 z vzporednim odpravljanjem posledic na kontaminiranih območjih, v letu 2012 pa je pripravila poročilo o izvajanju tematske strategije za varstvo tal in dejavnosti, ki potekajo v zvezi s tem. V letu 2014 Evropska komisija vodi nove aktivnosti na področju varstva tal zlasti v luči 7. Okoljskega programa, ki je bil sprejet v Evropskem parlamentu v letu 2013.

Abstract

In 2006, due to the need to address the issues of production capacity of soil, human health and environment risks, providing opportunities for climate change mitigation and adaptation to said change as well as business opportunities connected with the restoration, the European Commission proposed a framework Directive on soil protection, which also deals with cross-border consequences of soil degradation. Given the importance of soil and the need to prevent further soil degradation, the Thematic Strategy for Soil Protection was adopted in 2006, in accordance with the 6th Environmental Action Program. In 2011 the European Commission adopted the Roadmap for a resource-efficient Europe, with the aim to achieve no net land take by 2050 with remedial work on contaminated sites, and in 2012 she prepared the Report on the implementation of the Soil Thematic Strategy and ongoing activities. In 2014 the European Commission is conducting further activities in the field of soil conservation, especially in the light of the 7th Environment Action Program, which was adopted by the European Parliament in 2013.
